- Donald D. Landon Public Affairs Scholarship: \$500 (must have a FAFSA form on file with Financial Aid Office)
- Dr. Lloyd R. Young Scholarship: \$500 (must have a FAFSA form on file with Financial Aid Office)

All applicants must do the following:

1. Submit **4** copies of this application form, **4** copies of your written personal statement of no more than 1000 words, and **1** official copy of an up-to-date Missouri State University transcript. Your personal statement should include: *a summary of your accomplishments (including public service and dates service provided, if applying for the Landon or the Young Scholarship), and personal and academic goals.* You should have a FAFSA form on file with Financial Aid. Please list any other scholarships received for your education at Missouri State University (dates, funding source, and purpose). The application deadline is **Monday, April 3, 2006**.
2. Have two letters of recommendation sent to the Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminology by **Monday, April 3, 2006 (addressed to Scholarship Committee)**. We suggest that at least one reference letter is from an academic source.

Eligibility is determined as follows:

Scholarship in Societal Studies (\$1,000):

- 1) Must currently be majoring in Sociology, Anthropology, or Criminology
- 2) If sophomore level or higher, must be in good academic standing
- 3) Must be full-time student (12 or more hours) when applying for **and** when using the award.
- 4) Must demonstrate financial need

Donald D. Landon Public Affairs Scholarship (\$500):

- 1) Must currently be majoring in Sociology, Anthropology, or Criminology
- 2) Must be of junior standing with 60 or more credit hours or senior standing with 90 or more credit hours
- 3) Minimum of 3.0 grade point average
- 4) Must be full-time student (12 or more hours) when applying for **and** when using the award.
- 5) Should exhibit a record of public service

Dr. Lloyd R. Young Scholarship (\$500):

- 1) Must currently be majoring in Sociology, Anthropology, or Criminology
- 2) Must be of junior standing with 60 or more credit hours or senior standing with 90 or more credit hours
- 3) Minimum of 3.0 grade point average
- 4) Must be full-time student (12 or more hours) when applying for and when using the award.
- 5) Should exhibit a record of public service
- 6) Must demonstrate financial need

Two awards of the (\$1,000) Scholarship in Societal Studies will be made. One award will be made for each of the Landon and Young (\$500) scholarships. A student may apply for more than one scholarship, but cannot receive more than one.
